Soltec reports that, in accordance with Royal Decree-Law 23/2020, it has obtained the environmental impact assessment (DIA) favourable for sixteen photovoltaic plants in the Spanish regions of Murcia and Alicante, for a total capacity of 401 MW of peak power, of which 352 MW are in co-development with TotalEnergies, with a 35% percentage stake.

Consequently, Soltec has already obtained all the environmental impact assessments due in January 2023.
